Situation and impact of the Noto Peninsula Earthquake of 2024 on

our Company

We would like to express our deepest condolences to the victims and their families of the "Noto Peninsula Earthquake of 2024", which occurred on January 1, 2024. We also would like to convey our heartfelt prayers for the health of everyone in the affected areas and for the earliest possible restoration and recovery.

We would like to report on the damage to our Noto Plant (Shika-machi, Hakui-gun) and Technology Center (Hakusan City), which operate in Ishikawa Prefecture, caused by the Noto Peninsula Earthquake of 2024 and the impact of this earthquake on our company, as confirmed at this time.

1. Status of Damage

(1) Status of Human Suffering

At this time, no suffering has been confirmed among the Company's employees.

(2) Status of Physical Damage

There was no major damage to the Technology Center, which has been operating normally since January 5 (Fri.).

At the Noto Plant, damage to the building and some of the production facilities has been confirmed, and it is expected to take some time before production resumes to predisaster levels. We are taking steps to resume operations.

We will continue to ensure the safety of our employees as we work to restore production.

2. Impact on Future Business Performance

We are currently investigating the impact of the earthquake on our group's business performance.
